Evidence from God's Word on Its ORGANIZATION

In the New Testament church there was no earthly head office, and each congregation was independent. There were elders (qualified), (Acts 15:4; Acts 20:28; 1 Timothy 3:1-7), who are also called bishops or presbyters, who were responsible for the spiritual oversight. Deacons (qualified) (Acts 6:1-8; 1 Timothy 3:8-13), were responsible for the physical tasks. See I Tim. 3; Titus 1; Acts 20:28-31; Heb. 13:7, 17; and I Pet. 5:1-4, evangelists (2 Timothy 4:5; Ephesians 4:11; Romans 10:13-17), and members (Romans 12:4-5; 1 Corinthians 12:13-37). Philippians 1:1 presents this simple, but oh, so beautiful, organization: 'Paul and Timotheus, servants of Jesus Christ (evangelists) to all the saints in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi (members), with the bishops (elders) and deacons (special servants).
