What They Did

In the Appalachian Mountains there is a memorial to unknown soldiers who died. The memorial reads: "Who they were, no one knows. What they did, everyone knows."

We should certainly thank God for unknown heroes. Did you know that the eleventh chapter of Hebrews, a chapter that we commonly refer to as Faith's Hall of Fame, mentions some unsung heroes? After naming heroes like Noah, Abraham, and Moses, the Hebrew writer spoke of others who also made great sacrifices by faith. He wrote, "Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection: and others had trial of cruel mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds and imprisonment" (Hebrews 11:35–36).
