THE REALITY OF GOD

Is there a God? The world is divided between those who believe in God and those who do not. Who is right? What leads us to believe there is a God? By observation, we can know that a powerful force created this universe. We know because something cannot come from nothing. The Bible says that God has given evidence of Himself to the world (Romans 1:19). Then it says, “since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made” (Romans 1:20). Creation demands a Creator. We can set our watches and clocks by the Naval Observatory. But who is the author of time? Design demands a designer. Jesus said, “I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end” (Revelation 22:13). “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made (John 1:1-3). If we go too fast around a curve, we will go off the road due to the laws of nature. Who made that law? Laws demand that there be a Lawgiver. James 4:12 says, “There is only one Lawgiver”. Jehovah set in place all laws of nature; “It is he that sitteth upon

the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof are as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in” (Isaiah 40:22). The law of biogenesis means that life can only come from life. Therefore, Life demands a life giver. God said that everything reproduces after its own kind - (Vegetation, plants, animals, and human beings; Genesis 1:11, 24ff;). All living things will eventually die. Yet man will not cease to exist for “God formed man from the dust of the ground and breathed into His nostrils the breath of life and man became a living being” (Genesis 2:7). “In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return” (Genesis 3:19). “All flesh shall perish together, and man shall turn again unto dust” (Job 34:15). With these facts in mind, who would dare declare that there is no God?
