Sermons

AM — Have Ye Not Read

PM — Christianity Without Denominationalism?

It is the season that the world goes Immodest.

1 Tim 2:9-10 "In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array; But (which becometh women professing godliness) with good works."

Ben Bailey said recently in an article: "Directly after the knowledge of right and wrong, Adam and Eve attempted to clothe themselves, and the Bible says they sewed themselves coverings of fig leaves (Gen. 3:7-10). The Hebrew word for their garment is *chargorah*, which means a garment that covers the mid-section of the body and is tied about the waist. The same word is translated in other passages as a girdle or loin cloth. We know Adam and Eve's attempt was unsuccessful because they were still considered naked (Genesis 3:10-11). How did God feel about their skimpy dress? God considered their immodest attempt at dress as nakedness and God actually reclothed Adam and Eve (Gen. 3:10-11, 21). When God dressed Adam and Eve modestly, the Scripture says He made them tunics. Whatever this apparel that God made is will define God's standard for modesty. The Hebrew word for tunic is *kethoneth*, which describes a garment that reaches from the shoulders to at least the knees and is sometimes

sleeveless. It is very important to know that the **only** scripture that mentions God clothing mankind tells us He did so from the shoulders to at least the knees. What then have we learned about God's standard of modest dress?"

It is sad that when the weather warms up the clothes comes off. It is tragedy and a sin when a Christian acts like the world. 1 John 2:15-17 "Love not the world, neither the things [that are] in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever. "

Di you make yourself an enemy of God by the immodest clothing you wear (swimsuits, short, tight and see through clothing, etc.)? James 4:4 "Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God."

Let us resolve to let our light shine as Christians in how we dress. Let us set the example for modesty. Matt 5:16 "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven. " 2 Cor 4:6 "For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ."

Let us love Jesus Christ in that which we wear. John 14:15 "If ye love me, keep my commandments." We can keep his commandments and we can be a light unto the world in modesty. God demands it therefore because I love Jesus Christ and He loves me I will do this with all my heart. By Michael Golwitzer
