Our Finest Hour

On June 18, 1940, Winston Churchill stood before the crowded benches of the House of Commons. It was a desperate moment in British history. English armies had been flung back on the continent. Vast quantities of arms and ammunition had been lost. Enemy bombers were overhead.

In this desperate moment, Churchill was called to take his place as a leader of his nation. Standing before those benches, he finished his memorable utterance with these words: "Let us brace ourselves to our duties and so dedicate ourselves that if the British Empire and Commonwealth last for a thousand years, men will still say this was their finest hour."

Perhaps this was their finest hour. Many believe that Britons were never better than they were at that moment in history. This, too, can be our finest hour. Spiritual success requires having a strong belief in the power of God having confidence in others around you who are in similar battles with you and, yes, having confidence in yourself, by the grace of God. We all have something at which we can excel.
