## **“DEPART FROM EVIL, AND DO GOOD; SEEK PEACE, AND PURSUE IT”**

Psalm 34:14 is the verse that is used for the title of this article. In it, we find a good lesson for us as we plan our lives. We need to know what we are to do. We need something to fill our lives when we put something out of it. This verse gives us all of that.

We begin by departing from evil. As the people of God, evil is removed from our lives. We give no place to the Devil or to his workers (James 4:7). If evil is allowed to remain, even just a little, we will be overtaken by sin and lost (cf. I Corinthians 5:6). When we remove something from our lives, we need to fill this void with something. We are instructed, therefore, to do good. As Christians, we are to do good to all men (Galatians 6:10). We should look forward to doing good (cf. Galatians 2:10).

We are also taught to seek peace. The word of God will bring peace, since it is the “gospel of peace” (Acts 10:36; Romans 10:15; Ephesians 6:15). We are also taught to make this the goal of our lives – pursue it. We are taught to strive to live peaceably with everyone (Romans 12:18).

What this study should teach us is that we are

different than the world. We seek those things which will help us go to Heaven (Colossians 3:1,2), and nothing else really matters. Psalm 34:15,16, the verses following our key verse, teach us that God is open to the righteous, but is against those that do evil. Our entire relationship with God is based on whether we choose to depart from evil and do good. Which choice have you made?
