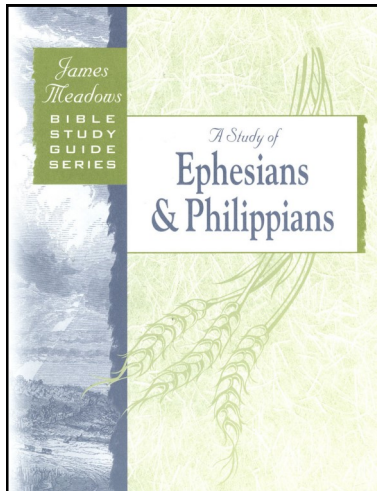

## Are You Sowing?

Matthew 13:3 “And he spake many things unto them in parables, saying, Behold, a sower went forth to sow”

WHAT—Precious seed Psalm 126:6 “He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him.”

HOW—In tears Psalm 126:6 “He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him.”

WHEN to Sow—Morning, evening, and always Ecclesiastes 11:6 “In the morning sow thy seed, and in the evening withhold not thine hand: for thou knowest not whether shall prosper, either this or that, or whether they both shall be alike good.”

WHERE—Beside all waters Isaiah 32:20 “Blessed are ye that sow beside all waters, that send forth thither the feet of the ox and the ass.”

Conclusion: Galatians 6:7 “Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.” We must sow the right seed—the Word of God Luke 8:11 “Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.”

Mountains and hills are mentioned more than 500 times in Scripture. Consider mountain scenes in his gospel: Jesus’ temptation (Matthew 4:8); The Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5:1-12); A number of healings (Matthew 15:29-31); The Transfiguration (Matthew 17:1); Jesus’ final discourse (Matthew 24:3); The commissioning of the Apostles (Matthew 28:16-20) and Transfiguration of Jesus (Matthew 17:1-13).

Noah’s Ark rests here after the flood (Gen 8)

Mount Sinai 7497 ft

Moses received the Ten Commandments (Exodus 19)

Mount of Olives 2710 ft. Jesus prays / is arrested and ascends into heaven (Luke 22, Acts 1)

Mount Zion 2510 ft. Solomon’s Temple

Mount of Tabor 1886 ft. Transfiguration

Mount Carmel 1724 ft. Elijah confronts the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18)
