**Lord's Supper: How To Focus Your Thoughts**  
**To focus your mind on the significance of the**  
**Lord's Supper, remember the number:**

**FIVE**--the number of times our Lord's body was pierced.  
(4) Four nails pierced his hands and feet to pin Him to the cross. (1) The sword pierced His side. (John 19:34)

**FOUR**--the number of parts into which His clothes were divided. (John 19:23-24) (4) The division of His clothes and the casting of lots for His robe were prophesied. (Psalm 22:16-18). All that happened to Him was planned from the beginning. (I Pet. 1:20, Rev. 13:8) (3)

**THREE**--the number of crosses.(1) One man dying for sins, one repentantly dying to sin, and (1) one rebelliously dying in sin. (Luke 23:39) Today, we are like one of the "other two." (1) Jesus Christ on the cross.

**TWO**--the number of eternal destinies. (2) Heaven and hell. (John 5:28-29) The worse destiny would have been ours without the events we remember during the Lord's Supper. (Rom. 3:23)

**ONE**--the uniqueness of the gift that the Father gave. (1) He gave His "only begotten" Son. (John 3:16, I John 4:10, Rom. 8:32)

## ***Twice as Good?***

Followed by a cloud of dust, the county agricultural agent drove up to the farmyard and bounced onto the porch. The farm was run-down, and the farmer, sitting in creaking rocker, showed neither excitement nor interest in his profession. The agent was just the opposite—enthusiasm personified. After a brief introduction he began to share what he thought were great ideas for improving the farm and increasing both production and income for the farmer and his family.
