GOD IS FAITHFUL

People often break their words and do not keep their promises in marriages, in business deals, and in dealing with children, friendships, and government. In such a world of broken promises, the Bible makes it abundantly clear that God is faithful. Note the following biblical assurances that Jehovah, the Lord, is faithful (with emphasis added).

Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he *is* God, **the faithful God**, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations (Deu. 7:9).

Thus saith the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, *and* his Holy One, to him whom man despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of **the LORD that is faithful**, *and* the Holy One of Israel, and he shall choose thee (Isa. 49:7).

God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord (1 Cor. 1:9).

There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but **God is faithful**, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear *it* (1 Cor. 10:13).

But **the Lord is faithful**, who shall stablish you, and keep *you* from evil (2 The. 3:3).

If we believe not, *yet he abideth faithful*: he cannot deny himself (2 Tim. 2:13). Let us hold fast the profession of *our* faith without wavering; (for **he is faithful** that promised;) (Heb.10:23).

Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls *to him* in well doing, as unto a **faithful Creator** (1 Pet. 4:19).

If we confess our sins, **he is faithful** and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9).

And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him *was* called **Faithful and True**, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war (Rev. 19:11).
