In 2 Timothy 2 Paul emphasizes the importance of THE CHRISTIAN LIFE:

1. SOLDIER—2 Timothy 2:3-4. Soldiers experience hardship but never give up. They fight the good fight and follow the orders of the King. The soldier who quits fighting before the battle is finished will never ever see victory.
2. ATHLETE—2 Timothy 2:5. The Christian life is not a short distance race; it's a marathon. We must finish our course. The athlete who stops running before the race is over will never ever win the race.
3. FARMER—2 Timothy 2:6. Farmers work hard planting and reaping. Christians work hard serving the Lord. The farmer who stops working before the harvest is complete will never ever see a fruitful harvest.
4. WORKERS—2 Timothy 2:15. We must handle correctly the Word of God, and in doing so, there will be no shame. The worker that is lazy will suffer shame in this life and on the Day of Judgment; however, the diligent worker honors God.
5. VESSELS—2 Timothy 2:20-21. Christians must be pure, holy, and true to be useful for the Master. The "great house" must have vessels that are honorable, clean, and useful.
