**AM and PM: Physical Prophecies of Christ**

**Preacher: Michael A. Golwitzer II**

## 2016 Gospel Meeting on “Search the Scriptures” John 5:39

Michael A. Golwitzer II from Radcliff church of Christ, Radcliff, Kentucky preached on Christ in Genesis explaining the “shadow” of Christ in the Old Testament.

He talked about Adam and Eve and how woman was created as a type of the church. The church being the bride of Christ. He talked about Cain and Able and how that was a type of the Jews and Christ. Jesus Christ innocent and righteous like Able but killed by his evil brother as was Christ. He taught about prophecies of Christ, the promise of Abraham and offering of Isaac as all pointing to Jesus Christ.

Saturday night’s sermon was about Samson. Samson was a point of analogy which points out the supreme sacrifice of Jesus Christ. Samson, though he was an awesome hero and judge of Israel, could not compare ultimately to our Savior and Lord. Michael made a comparison between Jesus and Samson in how they died.

This morning we will have a Bible Study of Christ and Jonah. The morning lesson and evening lesson will be about the Physical Prophecies of Christ. Brother Golwitzer will present seven physical prophecies of Jesus Christ. The Old Testament says Jesus Christ is coming and then nails down exactly who the messiah is and that he came. This gospel meeting shows the infinite wisdom of God and the inspiration of the scriptures. These lessons remind us of evidence that the Bible is inspired of God and perfect to bring us to Jesus Christ.

A little about our preacher for the Gospel Meeting. Michael A. Golwitzer II graduated from Kearsley High School and in 2002 from the Memphis School of Preaching. He completed his bachelor degree from Amridge University in Biblical Studies. In 2008, the Southern Christian University, Montgomery, Alabama, changed the institution’s name to Amridge University. He preached in Batesburg-Leesville, SC; Fort Wayne, IN; Elizabethtown, KY; Milan, MI; and Radcliff, KY. His success is largely because of his trust in Jesus Christ’s blessings and promises, love for truth, love for souls, and love for Bible study. He brings with him his children: Michael A. Golwitzer III, Caleb Golwitzer and Katelynn Golwitzer.

“But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which *vail* is done away in Christ.
