Preaching to turn the “world upside down “

Acts 17:1-6 “Now when they had passed through Amphipolis and Apollonia, they came to Thessalonica, where was a synagogue of the Jews: And Paul, as his manner was, went in unto them, and three sabbath days reasoned with them out of the scriptures, Opening and alleging, that Christ must needs have suffered, and risen again from the dead; and that this Jesus, whom I preach unto you, is Christ. And some of them believed, and consorted with Paul and Silas; and of the devout Greeks a great multitude, and of the chief women not a few. But the Jews which believed not, moved with envy, took unto them certain lewd fellows of the baser sort, and gathered a company, and set all the city on an uproar, and assaulted the house of Jason, and sought to bring them out to the people. And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain brethren unto the rulers of the city, crying, These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also”

Goelbel Music in his book “Behold the Pattern” on pages 451-452 had the following words in reference to turning the world upside down.

Have you wondered why we are not turning “the world upside down?” It may be because we are not reasoning or disputing like those of the first century (Acts 17:17; 19:4, 19). Acts 24:25 “And as he reasoned of righteousness, temperance, and judgment to come, Felix trembled, and answered, Go thy way for this time; when I have a convenient season, I will call for thee.”

1. Jesus Christ is the Christ, the Son of God. Acts 4:12 “Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.”
2. The church is the one body of Christ and one must come into contact with the blood of Christ to be in that one body. (Eph. 1:7; 1:22-23; 4:4-6; Col 1:18,24; Rev. 1:5)
3. Man cannot be saved out of the church, and one religious group is not as good as another (Eph. 5:23; Matt. 16:13-18)
4. The gospel of Jesus Christ is the only message in the world that has the power to save the soul of an, there is no other. (Matt 7:21-23; 7:13-14; John 8:32; 7:17; 17:17; 2 John 9-11; Gal. 1:6-9; 2 Thess. 1:7-9; 2:10-11)
5. Faithfulness to Christ must, absolutely mudt, be put above all other things and people (acts 21:13-14; 1 Cor. 4:11-13; 2 Cor. 6:1-10; 12:7-10; 2 Tim. 4:6-8; Rev. 2:10)

This type of preaching is required of us all the time. 2 Timothy 4:2 “Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.”

This does not mean in the summer or winter but when we like it and when we don't like it. Christianity is not seasonal. It is not weekly. Some think that being a Christian is only required on Sunday. It is a daily effort. We're to be a Christian when it is difficult and easy. God demands we never quite. Luke 9:62 "And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God."

We should all have a sense of urgency.

Colossians 4:6 "Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man."

Philippians 2:12 "Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling."

James 1:25 "But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed."

James 2:12 "So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty."

Titus 2:11-14 "For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ; Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works."

Saving grace and law are inseparable.


God's grace requires us to obey the Law. (John 14:15; James 2:12; 1 John 5:3-6; Luke 6:46; Matt. 7:21)
