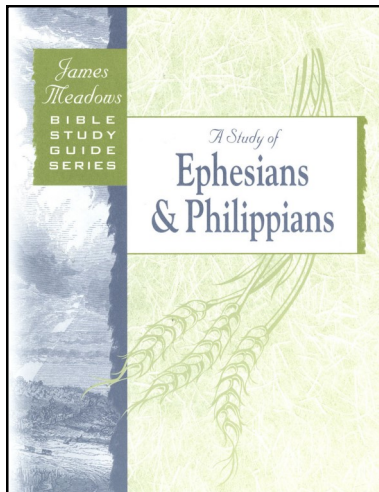

“WHAT IT MEANS TO BE A CHRISTIAN” IT MEANS BEING THE RIGHT EXAMPLE

In 1 Tim. 4:12, Paul exhorts Timothy to be an example of the believers. The word “example” that is used here means “a die”. It is that which makes an exact image of that which it imitates. Timothy’s life must be an exact replica of what a believer is to begin, Timothy is taught to let no man despise (“think against, disesteem”) his youth. He is to live a life that will not cause people to speak evil against his actions or words. The teaching for us is to be the right example. We do not ever want to be examples of the wrong thing. We also do not want to fool ourselves into thinking we are good examples when in reality our lives are not an exact replica of what a believer is—that is a believer to be an example in? Consider the rest of this verse.
