ANATOMY OF AN EVANGELISTIC CHURCH

MINDS that are like Christ's. "Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in the fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross" (Phil. 2:5-8; cf. 2:1-4; Matt. 20:28).

HEARTS filled with compassion for the lost. "Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be saved" (Rom. 10:1; cf. John 3:16-17; Luke 19:10; 1 Tim. 2:4; 2 Pet. 3:9).

EYES that are uplifted so they can see the fields of harvest. "Say not ye, There are yet

four months, and then cometh harvest? Behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields, for they are white already to harvest" (John 4:35; cf. Matt. 9:36-38).

EARS that are attuned to the instructions of God and the cries of the lost. "And a vision appeared to Paul in the night; There stood a man of Macedonia, and prayed him, saying, Come over into Macedonia, and help us. And after he had seen the vision, immediately we endeavoured to go into Macedonia, assuredly gathering that the Lord had called us for to preach the gospel unto them" (Acts 16:9-10; cf. Rom. 10:9-17).

TONGUES that speak God's word with boldness, "And now, Lord, behold their threatening: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word" (Acts 4:29; cf. Acts 20:20, 26-27; Matt. 28:18-20; 1 Pet. 3:15; 4:11; 2 Tim. 2:2).

FEET that are busy taking the gospel of peace to a world lost in sin. “And how shall they preach, except they be sent? As it written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!” (Rom. 10:15; cf. Mark 16;15-16; Acts 8:1-4).

HANDS that are outstretched to those in need. “As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith” (Gal. 6:10; cf. Acts 2:44-47; 4:32-37).

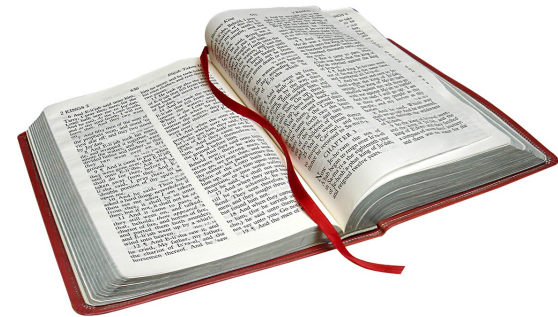
